

## Use of cookies on this website

### 1. About us – the operator

CAPITAL MARKETS, o.c.p., a.s., with its registered office at: Slávičie údolie 106, 811 02 Bratislava – Staré mesto district, Company ID No.: 36 853 054, registered in the Commercial Register of the Municipal Court Bratislava III, Section: Sa, file no.: 4295/B (hereinafter referred to as the “company” or “CAPITAL MARKETS, o.c.p., a.s.”) is the operator of the websites [www.capitalmarkets.sk](http://www.capitalmarkets.sk), [www.mnyman.eu](http://www.mnyman.eu) and [www.etfobchodnik.com](http://www.etfobchodnik.com) (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “website” in the appropriate grammatical form). CAPITAL MARKETS, o.c.p., a.s. holds exclusive rights or licences to the content of the website. ### 2. Cookies

A cookie is a small text file stored in the user’s web browser (e.g. Internet Explorer, Google Chrome, Firefox) on their computer (or on another device with internet access, e.g. a smartphone or tablet). This file enables visitors to our website to easily and quickly access personalised content whenever they return to a website they have previously visited. Information from cookies is accessible only to the server of the company that created them, and to no other. A cookie is merely a ‘passive’ file; it does not contain any additional software programs that could run on the user’s internet-connected device (computer, smartphone, tablet, etc.). Our website uses cookies. Cookies help us manage our website, provide its basic functionality and also help us understand how users use our website. We also use cookies for analytical and statistical purposes, such as recording the country of origin of our website users and the methods they use to visit our site. Specifically, we use the following types of cookies:

- a) **essential cookies**, which ensure the proper functioning of our website, for example by enabling you to log in to your user account on the site or allowing you to switch between language versions of our site and ensuring that your language preference is remembered. You can disable these cookies by changing your web browser settings, but the website may not function properly without them. You can find more information on how to change your web browser settings below in the section on Disabling/deactivating cookies. We process these cookies on the legal basis of pre-contractual/contractual relationships and our company’s legitimate interest.
- b) **Analytical cookies** help us analyse how you navigate our website, what content is relevant to you, and also learn more about the demographics of our users. We process these cookies on the legal basis of your consent.
- c) **Preference cookies** help us to tailor the content of our website to your interests (profiling). We process these cookies on the legal basis of your consent.
- d) **Advertising cookies** are used to display targeted and relevant advertising. We process these cookies on the legal basis of your consent.

Some cookies are deleted from your device once you close your web browser window (session cookies), whilst others remain stored on your device even after you have finished browsing our website (persistent cookies). Information on the storage duration of individual cookies can be found in the List of Cookies Used below.

We inform users about the use of cookies on our website via a banner located at the bottom of the website.

Google Analytics

This service from Google Inc. is an analytics tool which, by storing information in cookies, enables us to generate statistical reports on traffic to our website. #### Social media

#### Facebook and Instagram

If you click on the Facebook icon available on our website whilst you are logged in and/or registered to your Facebook account, the content of the website will be shared on your Facebook profile. The company would like to point out that, when you use our website, it has no influence over the data collected or the data processing procedures, and we are also unaware of the full scope of the data collected, the purpose of the processing or the retention periods for this data.
